The Minnesota Military Family Tribute will forever stand as a thank you to U.S. military, Gold Star, Blue Star and veteran family members.

This first of its kind tribute will be dedicated to Minnesota military families on Saturday, June 13th on the Minnesota State Capitol Grounds and consists of three elements to honor military and veteran families.

THANK YOU MILITARY AND VETERAN FAMILY WALKWAY

The promenade is expressed as a graceful arc which responds to the seasons. Majestic rows of trees line the path, providing shade in the summer and places of rest on benches below. Fall brings a symphony of color, as the trees turn from gold to red, finally dropping their leaves in the season of silhouettes. During winter, the ash-grey bark of the formal plantings create a contrast of color and texture with freshly fallen snow. In the spring, vibrant beds of flowering plants including red poppies announce the entrance to the Tribute as a tie to the memory of our veterans.

The beauty of the walkway in all seasons symbolizes a sweeping gesture of gratitude to all of Minnesota's military families and creates a feeling of home for them and all visitors.

The walkway is designed to support and embrace the existing memorials. The promenade opens up spaces south of the arc for two red gardens, and the pace north of the Walkway with broad open lawns. The lawns provide an area for families to program large gatherings and events.

GOLD STAR TABLE

At the west end of the promenade, the Gold Star Table recognizes the supreme sacrifice of our Gold Star families. The space features a sculpted table representing many narratives. It recalls the tables that we gather at as a family to share dinner, stories and laughter. It is a place of gathering, reflection and recreating memories.

In the home of a Gold Star Family, loved ones are reminded daily of their deep loss when they see any empty chair at their dinner table. The table in this Tribute has an element of transcendence, however, suggesting that one day these families will be reunited. Made of enduring bronze, its five-pointed foundation resembles the Gold Star. Northern hemisphere constellations shine through the table's surface, allowing light to pass through and creating a guide to the night sky. Polaris, the North Star is emphasized, a constant navigational guide home, and refers to our State's motto L'Etoile du Nord, The Star of the North. To older civilizations, the starts were used to map their way home.

STORY STONES

Minnesota soldiers hail from each of the state's 87 counties. 87 story stones are arranged into northern hemisphere constellations.

These stones serve as a unique visual connection between loved ones that are deployed, their families at home and the shared stars of the night sky.

Excerpts from correspondence sent between soldiers and their family members are etched onto these stones, and provide a window into the lives of our military families and their sacrifices.
